With its unique combination of metallurgical engineering expertise and production know-how, AMG is a leader in most of its markets which are critical to the production of key components for the aerospace, alternative energy (including solar and nuclear), electronics, optics, chemicals, and infrastructure industries. AMG has two operating divisions of businesses, Advanced Materials and Engineering Systems, and owns a majority interest in publicly-listed Graphit Kropfmuhl (GK) and a minority interest in publicly-listed Timminco Limited (TIM: TSX). AMG operates globally with production facilities in Germany, the United Kingdom, France, the United States, Canada, Mexico, Brazil and Australia with sales and service offices in Belgium, Russia, China and Japan. AMG employs approximately 3,000 people.

Ideal candidate will have the following qualifications and experience:

1. An outstanding academic record and degree from a top undergraduate institution; an engineering background is preferred but not required, MBA candidates will also be considered
2. Two to five years total work experience in, strategic consulting, investment banking, private equity or corporate development.
3. Deep analytical skills for performing -- existing and new market/industry analysis, competitive analysis, target acquisitions (and joint ventures) financial and business analysis. Analysis must be synthesized into well-written memos and presentations.
4. Exception listening and communication skills are essential elements in effectively interacting with the various cultures within AMG
5. Fluency in Germany language is required
6. Must be proactive on projects, demonstrate personal initiative and possess the capability to multi-task.
